

Eggplant Varieties

Astrakom: Compact 2'-3' tall plants, 4"-6" teardrop shaped fruit.

Calliope: Oval purple/white striped fruits up to 4" long.

Kyoto Egg: Round fruit 3" in diameter from Japan.

Nadia: Traditional black Italian type. Tall, sturdy, productive plants.

Nagasaki Long: Japanese heirloom, tender never bitter fruit is sweet enough to eat raw! Tolerant of heat and humidity.

Orient Express: High yielding, long slender deep purple fruits can grow up to 10".

Ping Tung: From Taiwan, elongated lighter purple fruit up to 18" long.

Purple Shine: Purple long Chinese variety. Very productive.

Rosita: Neon, lavender-pink bell-shaped fruits up to 8" long. From Puerto Rico.

Thai Round: Very productive, disease resistance variety produces small round fruit, green with white stripes. Very popular in India, Thailand and Vietnam.
